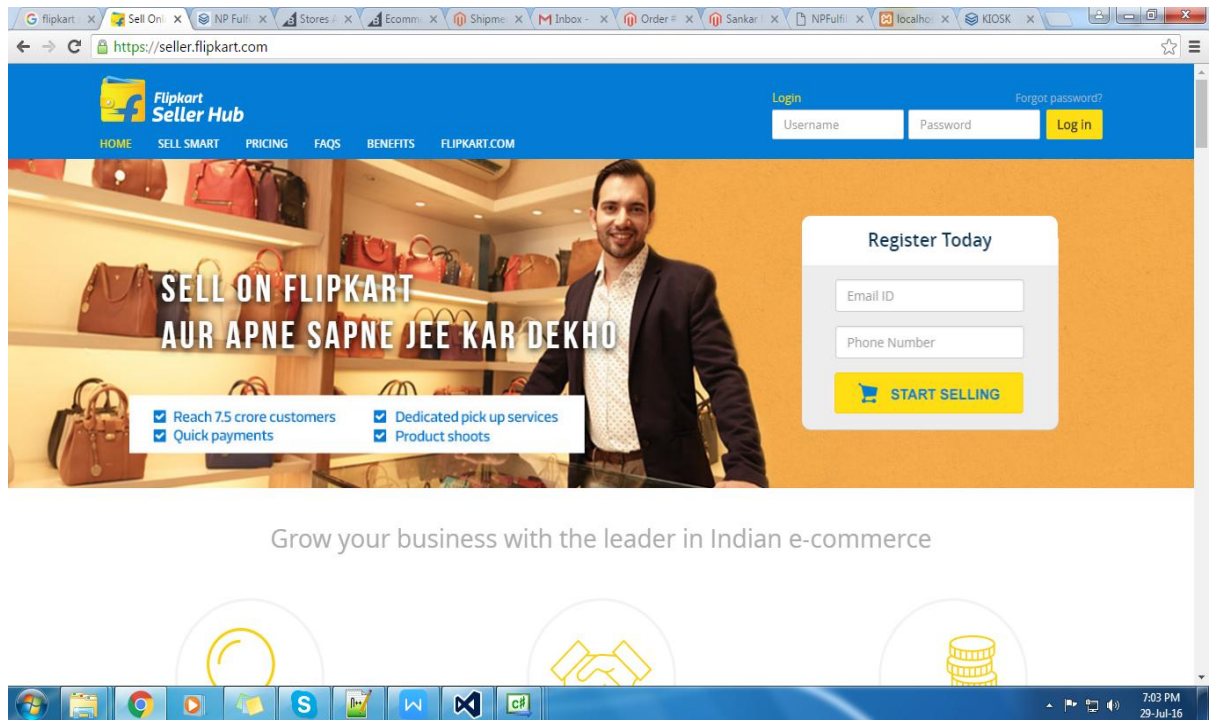

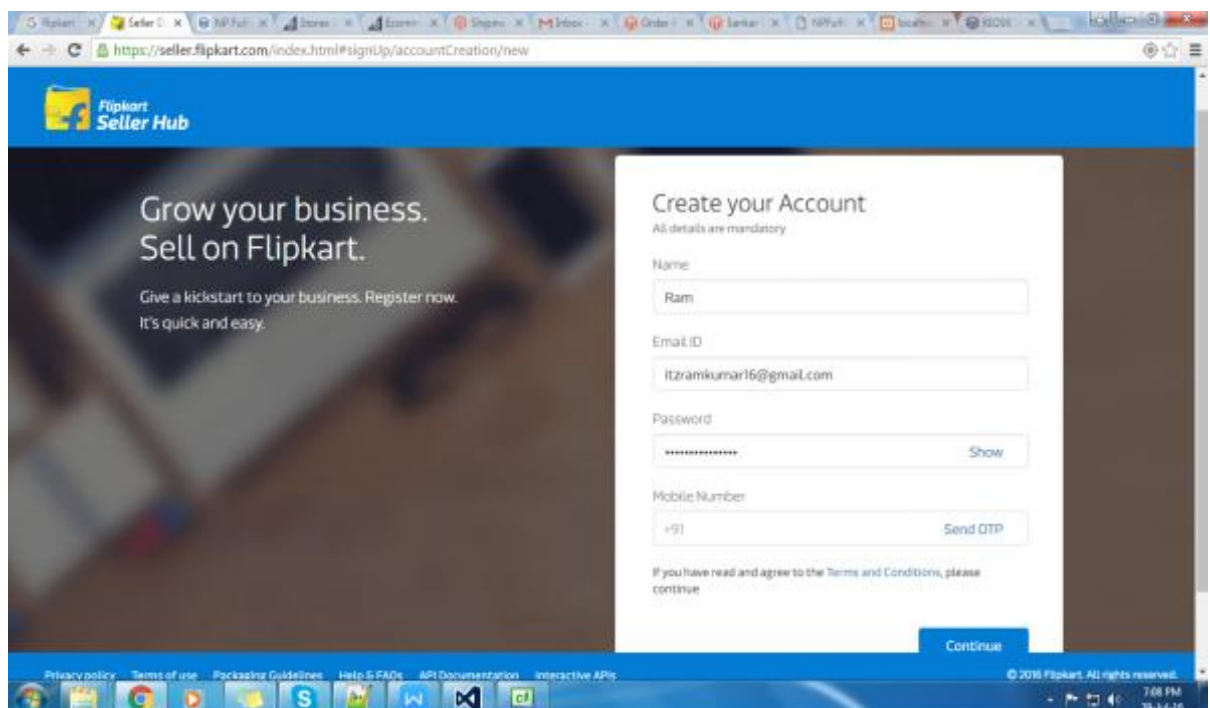
1) Create a New Account in Flipkart

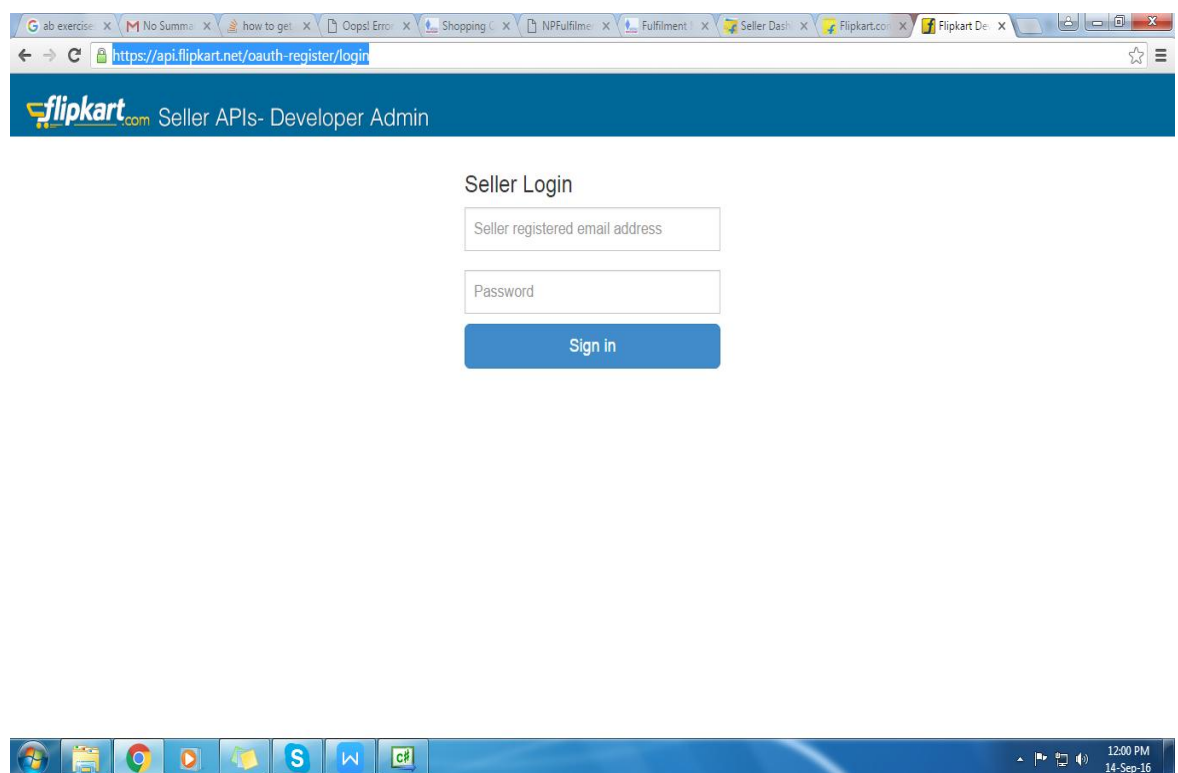
